APPOINTING DOUGLAS R. STOUDER AS THE MASON MUNICIPAL COURT PUBLIC DEFENDER, PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Jack T. Bunce has resigned as the Mason Municipal Court Public Defender; and

WHEREAS, Judge David Batsche has recommended consideration of Douglas R. Stouder for said position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six

<u>Section 1.</u> That Douglas R. Stouder is hereby approved as the Mason Municipal Court Public Defender.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the rate of compensation for said position will be \$4,777.76 per year, payable bi-weekly at \$183.76 per pay period.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective December 14, 1999. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to fill the position at the earliest possible date.
