ORDINANCE NO. 2000-115

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE WAGNER-SMITH COMPANY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF MASON-MONTGOMERY ROAD AND CEDAR VILLAGE DRIVE

WHEREAS, bids were received for the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection at Mason-Montgomery Road and Cedar Village Drive; and

WHEREAS, The Wagner-Smith Company was the best bidder with a bid of \$93,354.51 for said work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the bid of The Wagner-Smith Company in the amount of \$93,354.51 for the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Mason-Montgomery Road and Cedar Village Drive is hereby accepted as the best bid.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Wagner-Smith Company for the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Mason-Montgomery Road and Cedar Village Drive, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby directed to pay The Wagner-Smith Company the sum of \$93,354.51 for said work.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
