

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-156

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT WITH WAGNER SMITH COMPANY FOR THE
PURCHASE OF AN EARLY WARNING SIREN**

WHEREAS, bids were received for the purchase of an early warning siren; and

WHEREAS, Wagner Smith Company was the best bidder with a bid in the amount of \$20,125.00 for the purchase of an early warning siren.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio,
seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the bid of Wagner Smith Company is hereby accepted as the best bid for the purchase of an early warning siren.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Wagner Smith Company for the purchase of said siren in accordance with the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Wagner Smith Company the sum of \$20,125.00 according to the terms of the contract.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
