ORDINANCE NO. 2000-22

ADVISING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS TO THE BENEFITS OF ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY INCLUDED IN THE PETITION FOR ANNEXATION FILED BY CHARLES W. AND VIRGINIA F. ARAUJO TO THE CITY OF MASON

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §709.031(B) requires that a municipal corporation shall, by ordinance or resolution, adopt a statement indicating what services, if any, the municipal corporation will provide to the territory upon annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That upon annexation to the City of Mason, Ohio, of all or any part of the property included in the petition of Charles W. and Virginia F. Araujo, the City will provide, as set out under the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mason, access to sewer and water service, police, fire, paramedic, street maintenance, parks and recreation, building and zoning services to all or any part of the territory annexed. Said property contains approximately 29.376 acres located at 6666 Tylersville Road, and is more fully described on the attached Exhibit "A," which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Warren County Commissioners.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
