ORDINANCE NO. 2000-23

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH 32 FORD MERCURY, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2000 FORD F350 4X4 PICKUP TRUCK

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of pickup trucks; and

WHEREAS, 32 Ford Mercury, Inc. was the best bidder for the purchase of a 2000 Ford F350 4x4 pickup truck with a bid of \$27,438.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the State's pickup truck specifications and agrees that 32 Ford Mercury, Inc. is the best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with 32 Ford Mercury, Inc. for the purchase of a 2000 Ford F350 4x4 pickup truck for use by the Parks & Recreation Department.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay 32 Ford Mercury, Inc. the sum of \$27,438.00 for said pickup truck.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
