

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-14

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE A DRUG ABUSE RESISTANCE EDUCATION (DARE) GRANTS PROGRAM APPLICATION AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL, BETTY MONTGOMERY, TO CONTINUE A DARE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 62, known as the OMVI Law, was passed by the Ohio Legislature and signed into law effective October 1, 1993; and

WHEREAS, this law established the DARE Grants Program within the Office of the Attorney General; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason operates a DARE Program and recognizes the importance of providing expanded drug prevention and awareness service to its young citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **seven (7)** members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into agreement with the Ohio Attorney General to administer a grant to implement an expanded DARE Program.


Section 2. That the City of Mason hereby requests the Ohio Attorney General's Office to consider and fund this application.

Section 3. That if the City of Mason grant application is funded, the City agrees to share in the project cost as specified in the application, and to maintain operation of the DARE Program.

Section 4. That all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 5. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
