

RESOLUTION 2000-16

PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER AS OHIO PLANNING MONTH AND NOVEMBER 8TH
AS COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL PLANNING DAY.

WHEREAS, professional community and regional planners, planning commissions, zoning boards, city staff and citizen planners contribute much time and expertise each year to improving our villages, towns, cities and counties; and

WHEREAS, planning is vital to the appearance and livability of communities and the desirability of communities as locations for business, industry, and residential housing; and

WHEREAS, the high quality of life, health, safety and comfort that the citizens of Mason are accustomed to is directly related to the quality of planning performed by the Mason Planning Commission, City Council, Zoning Board, city staff and various citizen-based steering committees; and

WHEREAS, on November 8th and during the month of September, events will be held in the state of Ohio to highlight and commemorate the contributions of community and regional planners to urban and rural development,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the City of Mason, Ohio, members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio hereby designates and proclaims September, 2000, as Ohio Planning Month and November 8th as Community and Regional Planning Day in the City of Mason, Ohio.

Section 2. That all citizens of this community join with citizens of other communities throughout the country in recognizing the valuable contributions made each day by professional and citizen regional and community planners, not only in September during "Ohio Planning Month," but throughout the entire year.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law;
