**WHEREAS**, the Lady Comets were voted #1 in the Associated Press State Poll and the USA Today National Poll ranked them as #2; and


**WHEREAS**, the Lady Comets have had an outstanding season and exemplified the highest qualities of sportsmanship and competitive spirit; and

**WHEREAS**, the accomplishments and success of the Lady Comets have earned them the respect, admiration and support of their fellow students, families and community.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio:
