

RESOLUTION 2000-3

COMMENDING THE 1999-2000 MASON LADY COMETS BASKETBALL TEAM

WHEREAS, the accomplishments and success of the Lady Comets have earned them the respect, admiration and support of their fellow students, families and community.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Mason Lady Comets are hereby given the commendation of the Council of the City of Mason for their outstanding 1999-2000 season.

Section 2. That the Council does hereby resolve that the Mason Lady Comets Basketball Team are the 2000 State Champions.
