

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS BY THE MASON MUNICIPAL COURT FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTER HARDWARE, SOFTWARE AND SERVICE FOR THE NEW MASON MUNICIPAL COURT FACILITY, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Judge George M. Parker, Mason Municipal Court, has issued an order that computer hardware, software and service should be purchased from Buckeye Computers without advertisement or competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Judge has indicated that there exists a real and present emergency in connection with the purchase of said services and equipment; and

WHEREAS, said funds are to be expended from the Municipal Court Clerk's Computer Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, four members elected thereto concurring :

Section 1. That the Mason Municipal Court is hereby authorized to expend funds for the purchase of computer hardware, software and service for the new Mason Municipal Court facility.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a purchase order in the amount of \$27,430.00 payable to Buckeye Computers for the purchase of computer hardware, software and service for the new Mason Municipal Court facility, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the City Council determines that there is a real and present emergency.


Section 4. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Buckeye Computers in an amount not to exceed \$27,430.00 for said computer equipment.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
