

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-151

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT WITH 32 FORD FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3)
2003 FORD CROWN VICTORIA POLICE VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of police cruisers; and

WHEREAS, 32 Ford was the best bidder with a bid of \$21,811.00 per vehicle for a total of \$65,683.00 for the purchase three (3) 2003 Crown Victoria Sedans and one shop manual.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's police cruiser specifications and agrees that 32 Ford is the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with 32 Ford for the purchase of three (3) 2003 Crown Victoria Sedans for use as police cruisers.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay 32 Ford the total sum of \$65,683.00, being \$21,811.00 per vehicle for said police cruisers and one shop manual.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
