

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-157

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HENRY P. THOMPSON COMPANY FOR THE EQUIPMENT NECESSARY TO CONVERT THE SCADA SYSTEM FROM TELEPHONE LINE TO RADIO COMMUNICATION FOR THE WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, proposals were sought for the equipment necessary to convert the SCADA system from telephone line to radio communication; and

WHEREAS, Henry P. Thompson Company submitted the best proposal in an amount not to exceed \$94,727.48 for said equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the proposal of Henry P. Thompson Company in the amount of \$94,727.48 for the equipment necessary to convert the SCADA system from telephone line to radio communication is hereby accepted as the best proposal.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Henry P. Thompson Company for said equipment, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Henry P. Thompson Company an amount not to exceed \$94,727.48 for said services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
