

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-42

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DEFEASANCE OF THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO \$6,285,000 WATERWORKS SYSTEM MORTGAGE REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 1993, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN ESCROW DEPOSIT AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, on January 25, 1993, the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Mason, Warren County, Ohio (the "City"), passed Ordinance No. 93-10 authorizing the issuance of the \$6,285,000 of Water System Mortgage Revenue Bonds, Series 1993 (the "Series 1993 Bonds") for the purpose of improving the municipal water system; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined it to be in the best interest of the City to enter into an agreement with the City of Cincinnati, Ohio (the "City of Cincinnati"), to operate the Mason City Water System; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Indenture of Mortgage securing the Series 1993 Bonds requires the Series 1993 Bonds to be paid off or defeased before the City can enter into the proposed Retail Water Service Agreement with the City of Cincinnati (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, City Water Fund balances, together with the cash contribution from the City of Cincinnati required pursuant to the terms of the Agreement will be sufficient on February 28, 2002 to fully defease the Series 1993 Bonds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Warren County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. The outstanding \$4,870,000 principal amount of the Series 1993 Bonds shall be defeased on February 28, 2002.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Escrow Deposit Agreement with the Escrow Trustee to provide for the defeasance of the Series 1993 Bonds.

SECTION 3. This Council hereby appoints U.S. Bank National Association, the Trustee for the Series 1993 Bonds, to be the Escrow Trustee for the defeasance of the Series 1993 Bonds.

SECTION 4. The Finance Director and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents to effectuate the defeasance of the Series 1993 Bonds.

SECTION 5. This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 12. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
