

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-59

AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO, TO RESCIND CHAPTER 311 STREET OBSTRUCTIONS AND SPECIAL USES AND ENACTING NEW CHAPTER 311

WHEREAS, the City of Mason, Ohio, wishes to assure the safety and convenience of citizens in the use of public streets; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason, Ohio, wishes to provide standards related to the regulation of public streets and highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mason, Ohio, is hereby amended to rescind Chapter 311 Street Obstruction and Special Uses.

Section 2. That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mason, Ohio, is hereby amended to enact a new Chapter 311 Street Obstruction and Special Uses, as set forth in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
