

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-69

**REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR A NEXT GENERATION IP-BASED VOICE, DATA AND VIDEO COMMUNICATION SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, bids were sought for a Next Generation IP-based Voice, Data and Video Communication System; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that additional cost savings may be realized by including the local telephone and internet service with the telephone system in order to obtain the best price, and the bid received should therefore be rejected.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the bids opened on March 6, 2002 for a Next Generation IP-based Voice, Data and Video Communication System are hereby rejected.
