

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-35

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HOWELL CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF INFLUENT SEWER, WATER MAIN, AND RECLAIM WATER MAIN (CONTRACT B) NECESSARY FOR THE NEW WATER RECLAMATION PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the competitive bidding process, bids have been received for Influent Sewer, Water Main, and Reclaim Water Main (Contract B) necessary for the new Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, Howell Contractors, Inc. is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$1,673,850.00 for said Influent Sewer, Water Main, and Reclaim Water Main (Contract B).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Howell Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$1,673,850.00 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the Influent Sewer, Water Main, and Reclaim Water Main (Contract B) necessary for the new Water Reclamation Plant.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Howell Contractors, Inc. for the Influent Sewer, Water Main, and Reclaim Water Main (Contract B) necessary for the new Water Reclamation Plant, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Howell Contractors, Inc. an amount not to exceed \$1,673,850.00 for said Influent Sewer, Water Main, and Reclaim Water Main (Contract B).

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to secure the current bid and pricing of the contract.
