

ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 100

REPEALING SECTION 505.09 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO, AND ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 505.09 REGARDING BARKING OR HOWLING DOGS

WHEREAS, after consultation with the Mason Police Department, City Council has determined that substantial changes are necessary to effectively regulate animal noises in the City; and

WHEREAS, the most expeditious process is to replace section 505.09 in its entirety.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

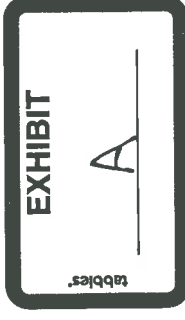
- Section 1.** That Section 505.09 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Mason, Ohio is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- Section 2.** That a new Section 505.09 is hereby adopted as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 3.** That this ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

505.09 BARKING OR HOWLING DOGS

- (a) No owner, keeper, or harborer of any animal shall negligently permit or allow such animal to disturb unreasonably, the peace and quiet of a neighborhood in which the animal is kept by frequent or continuing barking, howling, yelping or making any other animal noise.
- (b) As use in this section *NEGLIGENTLY* has the same meaning as in section 501.08(d) of the Mason Codified Ordinances.
- (c) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.
