

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH 32 FORD FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE F-350 PICKUP TRUCK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,913.00

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vehicles under the state bid program, including pickup trucks; and

WHEREAS, under Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04(C), the City of Mason may purchase a vehicle from another party upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications, but at a lower price than it can through the state bid program; and

WHEREAS, 32 Ford has provided a competitive bid for the purchase of one F-350 Pickup Truck, which bid is less than the bid for a vehicle with the same specifications under the state bid program, for a vehicle to be used by the Parks and Recreation Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's vehicle specifications and finds that 32 Ford's competitive bid meets or exceeds the State's F-350 Pickup Truck specifications and is less than the lowest bid obtained under the state bid program for such a vehicle.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with 32 Ford for the purchase of one F-350 Pickup Truck.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay 32 Ford the sum of \$40,913.00 for said vehicle.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
