

ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 7

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STANTEC, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$53,500.00, FOR CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES FOR PARTIAL DEMOLITION OF THE OLD WATER RECLAMATION PLANT

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has constructed a new Water Reclamation Plant (WRP) located at 3200 Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has taken the old WRP located at 3920 US 42 North out of service; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously entered into a contract with R.D. Zande and Associates, Inc., for design and preparation of bidding documents for the partial demolition of the old WRP; and

WHEREAS, bids have been received for the partial demolition of the old WRP and a contract has been awarded to the low bidder, Burns Construction, by Ordinance No. 2007-182; and

WHEREAS, Stantec, Inc., has proposed to furnish construction phase engineering services for the partial demolition of the old WRP for a total cost not to exceed \$53,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed this proposal and determined it to be reasonable and responsive to the City's requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the proposal of \$53,500.00 from Stantec, Inc., for construction phase engineering services necessary for the partial demolition of the old WRP.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Stantec, Inc., for the proposed work.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Stantec, Inc., a sum not to exceed \$53,500.00 upon successful completion of the agreed-upon services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
