

ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 97

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MICHAEL SCHUSTER ASSOCIATES ARCHITECTS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,550,700, FOR THE DESIGN AND PREPARATION OF CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS FOR ADDITIONS AND ALTERATIONS TO THE MASON COMMUNITY CENTER, AS PART OF THE PARTNERSHIP WITH TRIHEALTH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received proposals for the design and preparation of construction documents for additions and alternations to the Mason Community Center, as part of the partnership with TriHealth; and

WHEREAS, MICHAEL SCHUSTER ASSOCAIATES has the best proposal for said architectural services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the proposal of MICHAEL SCHUSTER ASSOCIATES in the amount of \$1,550,700 for the design and preparation of construction documents for additions and alternations to the Mason Community Center, as part of the partnership with TriHealth, is the best proposal.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with MICHAEL SCHUSTER ASSOCIATES for said architectural services, according to the conditions set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby directed to pay MICHAEL SCHUSTER ASSOCIATES up to the sum of \$1,550,700 for said work.



That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to have the architectural services available at the earliest possible date.
