

RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 4

ARBOR DAY

WHEREAS, Arbor Day has been an occasion for recognizing the value of trees and woodlands to human welfare since 1872; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason recognizes the value of trees as they clean the air, moderate the temperature, reduce topsoil erosion, cut heating and cooling costs, and provide wildlife habitat; and

WHEREAS, trees are a renewable resource and beautify our residential and business areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has a tradition of supporting and encouraging the planting, care and health of trees throughout the community.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
