

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 112

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLACK & VEATCH FOR PREPARATION OF A COMPREHENSIVE FINANCIAL STUDY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$41,500.00 PLUS DIRECT EXPENSES, OF THE MASON WASTEWATER AND STORMWATER UTILITIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Black & Veatch for preparation of a comprehensive financial study of the Mason Wastewater Stormwater Utilities, in accordance with the proposal submitted by Black & Veatch, which proposal is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Black & Veatch an amount not to exceed \$41,500.00, plus direct expenses, for said study.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to begin the study at the earliest possible date.
