

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 69

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARGILL, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF APPROXIMATELY 5,500 TONS OF ICE AND SNOW REMOVAL SALT AT \$62.99 PER TON

WHEREAS, the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government has advertised and received bids for the purchase of bulk ice control salt; and

WHEREAS, Cargill, Inc., was the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$62.99 per ton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government bulk ice control salt specifications and agrees that Cargill, Inc., is the lowest and best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cargill, Inc., for the purchase of 5,500 tons of salt, more or less.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Cargill, Inc., the sum of \$62.99 per ton.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
