

RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 2

**PROCLAIMING FEBRUARY 5, 2010, AS NATIONAL WEAR RED DAY,
IN SUPPORT OF THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION'S EFFORT
TO PROMOTE AWARENESS OF HEART DISEASE IN WOMEN**

WHEREAS, heart disease is the number one killer of women in America; and

WHEREAS, the American Heart Association needs our support of their ongoing research and education about women and heart disease in order to lead to a healthier future for all communities; and

WHEREAS, all are encouraged to join together to wear red to raise awareness and support the fight against heart disease in women.

WHEREAS, National Wear Red Day is on Friday, February 5, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason hereby designates and proclaims February 5, 2010, as National Wear Red Day in Mason.

Section 2. That February 5, 2010, National Wear Red Day, shall be set aside for supporting the American Heart Association in this awareness and support effort.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
