

ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 84

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BUNNELL ELECTRIC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$45,000 FOR INSTALLATION OF THE ELECTRIC IN THE MASON COMMUNITY CENTER TENANT SPACE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has solicited bids for the installation of electric in the exterior walls and owner work in the Mason Community Center Tenant Space; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has determined that the bid submitted by Bunnell Electric is the best bid on this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason determines that Bunnell Electric is the best bidder on the contract to install electric in the Mason Community Center Tenant Space in accordance with the specifications on file with the City, and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Bunnell Electric for \$45,000.00 for said project.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay to Bunnell Electric the amount due under the contract referred to in Section 1 of this ordinance.



That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
