

ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 87

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOW BID FOR THE WEST CHURCH STREET STORMWATER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FROM FORD DEVELOPMENT CORP. AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received on October 4, 2011 a total of seven competitive bids for construction of the West Church Street Stormwater Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, tabulation and analysis of the bids received on October 4, 2011 indicates that the lowest and best bid was provided by Ford Development Corp., in the total amount of \$189,896.90.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the contract for the West Church Street Stormwater Improvement Project is awarded to Ford Development Corp. at the bid amount of \$189,896.90.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Ford Development Corp. on behalf of the City of Mason.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Ford Development Corp. on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$189,896.90.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete construction and improve drainage in the West Church Street area at the earliest possible date.
