ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 82

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MERCER GROUP, INC. FOR THE RECONDITIONING OF THE BASEBALL FIELDS AT CORWIN NIXON PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$159,991.90 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote from Mercer Group, Inc. for the reconditioning of the baseball fields at Corwin Nixon Park in the amount of \$159,991.90; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Mercer Group, Inc. for the reconditioning of the baseball fields at Corwin Nixon Park in the amount of \$159,991.90.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Mercer Group, Inc. the not to exceed amount of \$159,991.90 for the reconditioning of the baseball fields at Corwin Nixon Park.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency to prevent the disruption of services.
