ORDINANCE 2019 – 23

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KINGS FORD INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIVE (5) FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR UTILITY VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$186,273.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vehicles and equipment under the State Bid Program; and

WHEREAS, Kings Ford Inc. was the best bidder with a bid of \$186,273 for the purchase of five (5) Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles for use by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the State's equipment specifications and agrees that Kings Ford Inc. is the best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Kings Ford Inc. for the purchase of five (5) Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Kings Ford Inc. the total sum of \$186,273 for said vehicles.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
