ORDINANCE 2019 – 26

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PENCHURA, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND ASSOCIATED MATERIALS FOR COMMON GROUND PARK IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$455,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of playground equipment; and

WHEREAS, Penchura, LLC is equal to or less than the best bidder with a price of \$455,000 for playground equipment and associated materials for Common Ground Park; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the State's specifications and agrees that Penchura, LLC is equal to or less than the best bidder for the purchase of playground equipment and associated materials.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Penchura, LLC for the purchase of playground equipment and associated materials for Common Ground Park.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Penchura, LLC up to the sum of \$455,000 for said playground equipment and associated materials for Common Ground Park.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That there is hereby appropriated from the Common Ground Park Construction Fund an amount of \$455,000.
- Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is secure 2018 pricing before the 2019 increase goes into effect.
