

ORDINANCE 2019 - 53

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CDW GOVERNMENT, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF NECESSARY LICENSING TO UPGRADE SERVER OPERATING SYSTEMS AND MICROSOFT OFFICE

WHEREAS, The City wishes to purchase the necessary licensing to upgrade its server operating systems and Microsoft Office; and

WHEREAS, City staff has obtained quotes for this licensing; and

WHEREAS, CDW Government Inc., has provided the lowest quote with a price of \$140,000 for the purchase of the necessary licensing to upgrade its server operating systems and Microsoft Office, with an initial annual fee of \$80,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason agrees that CDW Government, Inc. has provided the lowest quote for the desired licensing.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with CDW Government, Inc. for the purchase of the necessary licensing to upgrade its server operating systems and Microsoft Office.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay CDW Government, Inc. the sum of \$140,000 for said licensing and an additional annual fee initially identified as \$80,000, which fee may be adjusted in the future based on fee increases or a change in the number of employees.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
