ORDINANCE 2019 - 54

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VERMONT SYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF UPGRADED RECTRAC SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, The City wishes to purchase upgraded RecTrac software; and

WHEREAS, City staff has obtained quotes for this software; and

WHEREAS, Vermont Systems, Inc., has provided the lowest quote with a price of \$49,000 for the purchase of such software, with an initial annual fee of \$34,800.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason agrees that Vermont Systems, Inc. has provided the lowest quote for the desired software.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Vermont Systems, Inc. for the purchase of upgraded RecTrac software.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Vermont Systems, Inc. the sum of \$49,000 for said software and an additional annual fee initially identified as \$34,800, which fee may be adjusted in the future based on fee increases or a change in the number of employees.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
