ORDINANCE 2019 – 62

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STAUFFER SITE SERVICES, LLC FOR PINE HILL DAM SECONDARY SPILLWAY RESTORATION WORK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$32,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote from Stauffer Site Services, LLC, for Pine Hill Dam Secondary Spillway Restoration work in the amount of \$32,000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Stauffer Site Services, LLC, for Pine Hill Dam Secondary Spillway Restoration work according to the specifications set forth by the City.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Stauffer Site Services, LLC, an amount not to exceed \$32,000 for Pine Hill Dam Secondary Spillway Restoration work.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of an emergency is the need to authorize the payment for the labor and materials at the earliest possible date.
