ORDINANCE 2019 - 85

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH A VENDOR FOR EMERGENCY CULVERT REPAIR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a culvert failure has presented the City with a dangerous situation in need of emergency repair; and

WHEREAS, City staff is diligently working to identify an appropriate vendor to make such repair before additional road damage is suffered; and

WHEREAS, preliminary estimates have identified that such emergency repair work can be completed in an amount not to exceed \$50.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with a subsequently identified vendor for emergency culvert repair.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is authorized to pay said vendor an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for said emergency repair work.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete the repairs at the earliest possible date to avoid significant damage to the roadway and the alleviate an existing dangerous situation.
