

ORDINANCE 2019 - 104

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JOHN TUMLIN AND SONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,740 FOR LABOR AND MATERIAL RELATED TO THE BUILDING RENOVATION AND INSTALLATION OF AN OVERHEAD DOOR IN BUILDING #2 AT THE SAFETY AND SERVICE CENTER ANNEX

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote, in the amount of \$30,740 from John Tumlin and Sons, Ltd. to provide the associated labor and materials related to the renovation of the building and installation of an overhead door in Building #2 at the Safety and Service Center Annex on U.S. 42; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with John Tumlin and Sons, Ltd. to provide labor and materials related to the building renovation needed for the installation of an overhead door for police impound facility needs in Building #2 at the Safety and Service Center Annex.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay John Tumlin and Sons, Ltd. an amount not to exceed \$30,740 to provide labor and materials related to the building renovation needed for the installation of an overhead door for police impound facility needs in Building #2 at the Safety and Service Center Annex.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
