

ORDINANCE 2019 – 115

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE RUSH TRUCK CENTER OF OHIO FOR ENGINE REPAIRS TO A 2009 INTERNATIONAL 7400 DUMP TRUCK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,956 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, an engine failure in a 2009 International dump truck has presented the City with an immediate need of emergency repair; and

WHEREAS, City staff worked to quickly identify an appropriate vendor to make such repair before winter; and

WHEREAS, preliminary estimates have identified that such emergency repair work can be completed in an amount not to exceed \$30,956.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with a the Rush Truck Center of Ohio for emergency engine repair.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is authorized to pay the Rush Truck Center of Ohio an amount not to exceed \$30,956 for said emergency repair work.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete the repairs at the earliest possible date to avoid being without a frontline snow plow truck for the upcoming season.
