ORDINANCE 2019 – 116

AUTHORIZING A PAYMENT TO GREATER CINCINNATI WATERWORKS FOR A COMMERCIAL METER PERMIT FEE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$155,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, as part of the Mason Aquatic Center project, it will be necessary to obtain a permit for a 6" commercial water meter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Greater Cincinnati Waterworks an amount not to exceed \$155,000 for a 6" commercial meter permit fee.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to install a water meter pit at the earliest possible date in order to avoid construction delays for the Mason Aquatic Center Project.
