

ORDINANCE 2019 – 137

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FOR DESIGN OF THE MASON MUNICIPAL AQUATIC CENTER 50-METER ENCLOSURE BUILDING FROM CHAMPLIN ARCHITECTURE, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FEE OF \$242,500 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received a proposal for design the Mason Municipal Aquatic Center 50-Meter Enclosure Building; and

WHEREAS, Champlin Architecture, is most qualified consultant to design the Mason Municipal Aquatic Center 50-Meter Enclosure Building as outlined in a proposal in an amount not to exceed fee of \$242,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the proposal for the Mason Municipal Aquatic Center 50-Meter Enclosure Building is authorized for Champlin Architecture, for the not to exceed fee amount of \$242,500.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Champlin Architecture on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Champlin Architecture on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$242,500.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
