PROCLAIMING MAY 2019 AS MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH AND EDUCATION DAY MAY 5

WHEREAS, Mental Health Awareness Month strives to raise awareness and educate the public about mental illnesses, and strategies for attaining mental health and wellness.

WHEREAS, Myriad Nueroscience is a Mason based precision medicine company dedicated to helping patients suffering from depression, ADHD or chronic pain get on the right medication so they can live active, fulfilling lives; and

WHEREAS, The Genesight test was developed in the Myriad Nueroscience clinical laboratory has assisted more than one million people on the path to wellness

WHEREAS, Lindner Center of HOPE advocates for mental health and wellness as a core focus for every individual in the community; and

WHEREAS, 60 million people in the United States face the day-to-day reality of living with a mental illness.

WHEREAS, 1 in 5 adults in the U.S. -43.8 million, or 18.5% experience mental illness in a given year.
