Who is eligible to be a food vendor?

Applicants must...

- Have <u>all</u> necessary licenses and insurance.
- Be year-round and or seasonal operation with proven festival and similar event experience.
- Be self-sufficient; contain a 3 compartment sink for washing/ rinsing/ sanitizing, adequate refrigeration, full provision of power utilities including electrical, LP gas or a portable quiet power generation unit (Eu Inverter Generators only), a portable water holding tank and a liquid waste disposal system.

Where/ How do I apply?

The attached application is the only application that will be accepted. You can also visit the City of Mason's Website at www.imaginemason.org for the application and additional details. Full and complete applications must be received by May 15, 2023.

When and How are Vendors selected?

All applications will be reviewed and participants will be selected on or before June 1, 2023 and will be contacted at that time via email. A waiting list will be created in the event of cancellations. Special preference will be given to Vendors based on the following:

- A Vendor has a strong previous relationship with the City of Mason or is located in the City of Mason.
- A Vendor has a unique item(s) not provided by other Vendors.
- A Vendor has a clean and attractive serving station.
- A Vendor has practical and reasonable pricing.
- A Vendor has submitted payment in full and all required documentation to Food Court Manager.

Important Dates:

June 1st	Final food vendor selection. All food vendors will be notified by email.
June 15th	All fees must be paid in full and certificate of insurance and food service license must be submitted and received by SuperGames
June 15th	Special Event Coverage Insurance payment due. (if specified by application)

Fees:

20x30 space- \$400 Includes one assigned parking space for Vendor's personal vehicle for duration of entire event (allotted space is standard public parking space 18x9).

What items may be sold by Food Vendors?

Your menu will be restricted to approved items only. Please do not bring items that have not been approved by the Food Court Manager. Food vendors may sell their own soda and water however only beverage products offered by the City of Mason's exclusive beverage provider can be sold. No other beverage brands can be sold or marketed. The City of Mason is currently in the process of finalizing their beverage services contract and will relay the specific brand to vendors upon their selection on June 1.

Cost per individual food vendor is \$73. Each selected food vendor requiring such a policy must submit payment by June 15, 2023 (checks made payable to: The City of Mason). A complete and approved vendor application is required with all payments.

II. Vendor Regulations

- a. Maximum of four (4) main and four (4) lesser menu items permitted, including beverages PER booth. Example: If two booths are requested, then up to eight (8) main and eight (8) lesser items permitted, etc.
- b. Food vendors may sell their own soda and water however product MUST be the same brand as the City of Mason's exclusive beverage provider. This includes product for personal and staff use. No other beverage brands can be sold or marketed. The City of Mason is in the process of finalizing their beverage services contract and will relay the specific brand to vendors upon their selection on June 1.
- c. Festival Date and Time (rain or shine) Monday, July 3, 2023 4:00PM 10:00PM

III. Confirmation

a. Upon receipt of applications (including current license(s), certificates of insurance (naming both SuperGames and The City of Mason as additional insured), a confirmation email will be sent to the email address provided within application.

All fees are due by June 15, 2023

- b. Vendors will receive complete staging instructions (including times, parking/ parking pass information, set-up and tear-down requirements, etc.) via email no later than June 15, 2023.
- c. A map will be enclosed with your staging information showing directions on where to load/unload and park.
- d. Upon approval by Food Court Manager, all fees, permits and insurance will be due by June 15, 2023.
- e. Applications can be refused for any reason.

IV. Staging Rules (including set-up/tear-down)

- a. Vendors are responsible for all necessary labor and set-up duties during staging. Event staff/ volunteers are not and will not be allowed or permitted to assist vendors.
- b. Vehicles permitted into food court up to one (1) hour during the following times **only**: Friday, July 3 from 10:00AM 2:00PM
- c. For the safety of Event visitors, staff and vendor staging directions must be respected.
