

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 46

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CINCINNATI BELL TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS TO UPGRADE THE CURRENT CITY TELEPHONE SYSTEM IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEED \$53,586.65

WHEREAS, the City currently utilizes the Cisco Call Manager Phone System hardware, software and licensing; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is necessary to upgrade the current system; and

WHEREAS, Cincinnati Bell Technology Solutions has provided a proposal to upgrade the current system hardware, software and licensing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, with six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Cincinnati Bell Technology Solutions in an amount not to exceed \$53,586.65 in order to upgrade the current Cisco Call Manager Phone System hardware, software and licensing.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Cincinnati Bell Technology Solutions an amount not to exceed \$53,586.65 in accordance with the proposal submitted by Cincinnati Bell Technology Solutions.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
