ORDINANCE 2015 - 72

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH INDIANA RELINE, INC. FOR ALL LABOR AND MATERIALS NECESSARY TO SLIP LINE AN EXISTING 84" DIAMETER CULVERT UNDER INNOVATION WAY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$340,920 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were solicited for slip lining an existing 84" diameter corrugated metal culvert that crosses under Innovation Way; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Reline was the best bidder with a bid of \$325,920 for the materials and labor necessary for completion of the slip lining;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Indiana Reline, Inc. for the materials and labor necessary to slip line an existing 84" diameter corrugated metal culvert that crosses under Innovation Way.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Indiana Reline, Inc. the total sum of up \$340,920 for said service, including \$15,000 of contingency funds.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to provide and install the equipment as soon as possible to allow for vehicle maintenance operations to begin at the new service center.
