

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014 - 13**

**SUPPORTING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INNOVATION FUND BY THE CITY OF LOVELAND, OHIO, IN ORDER TO FUND A FIRE TRAINING TOWER FOR LOCAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND REGIONAL COOPERATION**

**WHEREAS**, providing for the safety of community is a primary function of local government; and

**WHEREAS**, training for fire and emergency medical services personnel is important for the safety of our citizens; and
